The **National Honor Society** (NHS) is a national organization established to recognize outstanding high school students. More than just an honor roll, NHS serves to recognize those students who have demonstrated excellence in the areas of scholarship, service, leadership, and character. The deadline for the application is November 23rd, 2022. After the applications have been reviewed, eligible candidates will be granted an interview with the advisor and possibly current members of the NHS.

After I am accepted as a member of NHS, what is required of me?

NHS members are required to complete at least 30 hours of community service (this will be discussed further if you are granted an interview). Members are responsible for keeping track of all service hours, both in-and-out of school. Members must also attend at least two NHS meetings a year and are expected to email me if you are unable to attend a meeting. Members are required to maintain a GPA of at least a 3.4 and will be expected to check-in with your guidance counselor at least twice a year to confirm your GPA status. Lastly, members are expected to attend at least three after school tutoring and homework help sessions.
