

Minuteman High School COVID-19 Caregiver and Student Acknowledgement

We are following the Department of Public Health (DPH), Center for Disease Control (CDC), and Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE) guidelines to protect the students and staff during the COVID-19 pandemic. **Students, with the assistance of families, must be monitored daily for symptoms prior to school.** Students must stay home if feeling unwell. Everyone must do their part to protect others and not come to school if they are exhibiting any COVID-19 symptoms or are feeling sick.

- I understand that students cannot come to school if they have any COVID-19 symptoms:
 - Fever (100° Fahrenheit or higher)
 - Chills or shaking chills
 - Cough (not due to other known cause, such as chronic cough)
 - Difficulty breathing or shortness of breath
 - New loss of taste or smell
 - Sore throat
 - Headache when in combination with any other symptom
 - Muscle aches or body aches
 - Nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea
 - o Fatigue when in combination with any other symptom
 - Nasal congestion or runny nose (not due to other known causes, such as allergies) when
 in combination with any other symptom
- If my child has any of the above symptoms, I will contact the school for guidance
- I understand that my child will not be allowed in the building if they:
 - o Have recently tested positive for COVID-19 or have a pending COVID-19 test
 - Have been in contact with a person who has been diagnosed with COVID-19 within the past 14 days
 - o Are currently under instruction to quarantine due to possible COVID-19 exposure
 - Have traveled outside the United States within the past 14 days
 - Have traveled domestically within the United States by car, commercial airline, bus or train, etc. within the past 14 days to any high-risk states determined by the Massachusetts COVID-19 Travel Order
- I understand that my child will be expected to:
 - Wear a mask/face covering at all times while in the building (except during scheduled mask breaks and lunch/snack)
 - Maintain 6 feet of social distance from others at all times while in the building *with the exception of Career/Vocational Technical Education (CVTE) guidelines
- I understand that if my child begins to exhibit any of the above possible COVID-19 symptoms
 during the school day, they will be assessed by the nurse and I will be contacted for immediate
 dismissal
- If any symptoms are experienced, for my child to return to the building, I will need to show proof of a negative COVID-19 test or they must quarantine per local/state guidelines
