

Dual Enrollment Academy

For High School and Home-Schooled Students

Get a head start on your college degree

The Middlesex Dual Enrollment Academy allows qualified high school and home-schooled students to begin earning college credit while satisfying their high school graduation requirements. Students may select courses that are offered through MCC online or on campus during the school day, at night, or on the weekend. Flexible options are available for students who want to focus on Science, Math, Engineering and Technology, Health Professions, Business Administration and for students who just want to get a head start on completing the general education courses required by most colleges and universities.

Academic and student support services, including specialized advising, career counseling, transfer counseling, tutoring, computer labs, and library access are provided to maximize success. Admitted students are eligible to participate in college sponsored activities and clubs.

Cost

Middlesex is pleased to offer dual enrollment courses at a reduced cost. Some courses may have additional fees, such as lab or technology fees. Limited funding from the Commonwealth of Massachusetts may be available to state residents to cover the cost of courses that are 3 or more credits that meet one of the following criteria:

- are within a discipline that qualifies under the MassTransfer Block,
- are part of the curriculum of approved associate degrees linked to baccalaureate programs under MassTransfer; OR
- · are in computer science, technology or engineering.

The disciplines represented in the MassTransfer Block are behavioral and social sciences, humanities and fine arts, natural or physical science, English composition/writing, and mathematic/quantitative reasoning. Students must have a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 to qualify for state funding. Since funding is limited, you are strongly encouraged to complete the application process as early as possible.

Admission Requirements

- Completion of the Middlesex Dual Enrollment Academy Application, including the required approvals and certifications from a parent or guardian and either a high school guidance counselor or home school advisor. Home school students must provide evidence of school district program approval.
- Submission of an official high school transcript or the equivalent for a home-schooled student, documenting a minimum of a C grade point average. (Continued enrollment in the program requires a minimum of a 2.0 grade point average at Middlesex).
- 3. Completion of Middlesex Community College Placement testing.
- 4. Attendance at a dual enrollment orientation session with a parent or guardian. Orientation session dates are available at https://www.middlesex.mass.edu/dualenroll/

Application Process

- Meet with your guidance counselor to discuss your interest in the Middlesex Dual Enrollment Academy. Confirm your eligibility and begin to identify coursework that will satisfy both high school and college requirements. Home schooled students should determine what courses they wish to take.
- 2. Complete the Middlesex Dual Enrollment Academy Application with the required signatures.
- 3. Make an appointment to take the Middlesex Community College placement test by calling 1-800-818-3434. Students must achieve a minimum score of 33 out of 120 on the reading portion of the test. Placement testing will determine the courses you are eligible to take. Students must satisfy all prerequisites for selected courses prior to beginning the course.
- Mail the application and official high school transcript to: Middlesex Community College, Enrollment Communications and Support Department, 33 Kearney Square, Lowell, Massachusetts, 01852.

- Once your application is reviewed, you will receive a letter regarding your admission status to the Dual Enrollment Academy.

After You Have Been Admitted

Register for classes — A Middlesex Dual Enrollment Academy Advisor will work directly with each student, parent, and guidance counselor to select appropriate Middlesex courses that meet high school and college requirements and to complete the registration process. Please call 1-800-818-3434 to make an appointment. You will be required to complete the registration form that was included with your admission letter and bring it to this appointment. Please make certain all necessary signatures are included.

Students should complete the application process at least one month prior to the start of classes — early August for Fall Semester, mid-December for Spring Semester, and early May for Summer Semester. You must be enrolled prior to the first day of classes.

Please note:
