- Superintendent's report
 - Educational Program plan was submitted to the Department of Education and reviewed this past week with the chair of the MetroWest Regional Employment Board
- Non-MSBA Plan Report
 - Creating an executive summary of the changes necessary to repair the building including costs and phasing
- Communications Committee Report
 - Identified the need for a consultant and are looking at other options outside the state bid list and trying to define exactly what we are looking for.
 - Created a calendar of when we need to reach out to member communities and who needs to be spoken to.
- Design Options
 - Design team has met with the Lincoln planning board and is planning to meet with the Lexington planning board to discuss permitting, utilities, etc.
 - Towns have expressed an interest in working together on permitting issues.
 - Design team has come up with imagery to depict what might the building look like
 - There is about a 20 ft height elevation in the area where the new building would go so further investigation is necessary
 - Consensus seems to be that we would prefer as much utilization of solar panels as possible.
 MSBA does not reimburse for solar panels.
 - With approval of the current direction, the Design Team can begin to develop narratives, cost estimates, and what construction scheduling would look like.
 - The Design Team can provide a range of estimates to compare operating costs between the building options
 - The spaces will allow for flexibility but the building still needs to be designed with specific programs in mind due to the specific nature of some shop spaces.
 - There is not much space to expand in the instance of increased enrollment
